#1 Amazon Restructures Healthcare Business

What Happened:

Amazon restructures its healthcare business after executive departures.

Amazon Health Services will now focus on six groups within its One Medical and overall AHS units.

#2 23andMe Ownership Changes - Again

What Happened:

TTAM Research outbids Regeneron Pharmaceuticals for 23and Me assets.

Why It Matters:

23andMe co-founder and former CEO Anne Wojcicki's non-profit outbids Regeneron Pharmaceuticals to acquire the bankrupt company's assets for \$305 million.

#3 Healthcare AI Companies Raise \$193M

What Happened:

Nabla, Ellipsis Health, and Autonomize AI raise a combined \$193 million.

Why It Matters:

Investors continue to show their interest in healthcare AI companies, funding Nabla (ambient scribe tech), Ellipsis (agentic AI), and Autonomize (copilots).

#4 Glytec Raises \$36M

What Happened:

Glytec announces \$36 million in new funding.

Why It Matters:

The diabetes management software vendor will use the investment to further expand its Glucommander SaaS offering as providers gear up for new CMS quality measures related to inpatient glycemic control.

#5 MRO Acquires Q-Centrix

What Happened:

MRO acquires Q-Centrix for an undisclosed amount.

Why It Matters:

MRO will integrate Q-Centrix's clinical data management capabilities with its clinical data exchange offering.
