#1 Samsung to Acquire Xealth

What Happened:

Samsung will acquire digital health integration company Xealth.

#4 Symplr Acquires Smart Square Software

What Happened:

Symplr acquires AMN Healthcare's staff scheduling software.

Why It Matters:

The \$75 million tech acquisition will enable Symplr to enhance its healthcare workforce operations platform.

#5 Mayo Clinic Develops Dementia AI Tool

What Happened:

Mayo Clinic develops an AI tool that can identify nine types of dementia.

Why It Matters:

The tool can identify the brain activity patterns of nine types of dementia, including Alzheimer's disease, from a single PET scan.
