#1 Hims & Hers to Acquire Eucalyptus

What Happened:

Hims & Hers will acquire Australia-based Eucalyptus for \$1.15 billion.

Why It Matters:

Hims & Hers' decision to acquire Eucalyptus, which operates digital healthcare clinics for five separate brands, furthers its global expansion strategy.

#2 RevSpring Acquires TrustCommerce

RevSpring acquires TrustCommerce, an integrated payment platform vendor.

Last week's ransomware attack has forced University of Mississippi Medical Center to close its clinics, revert to downtime procedures, and bring in outside cybersecurity help from federal agencies as it communicates with the hackers.

#4 SEC Concludes Veradigm Investigation

The SEC's investigation of Veradigm ends without enforcement action.

Why It Matters:

Conclusion of the years-long investigation will allow the company to finally move forward with its plan to stabilize operations and refocus strategy, including the recent decision to discontinue six low-revenue products.
