# #1 Findhelp Announces New Funding

# #4 Vendors File Motions to Dismiss Epic's Lawsuit

Health Gorilla and LlamaLab file motions to dismiss Epic's lawsuit.

The motions to dismiss, each filed for their own distinct reasons, ensure a lengthy legal dispute with Epic, which contends that the matter with Health Gorilla should be resolved transparently in a federal court.

# #5 AHA Requests Changes to HTI-5 Proposed Rule

## **What Happened:**

AHA asks ASTP/ONC for seven changes to the HTI-5 proposed rule.

## **Why It Matters:**

The requested changes, if granted, would give health IT stakeholders - particularly rural providers with limited resources - more time to adjust to new interoperability requirements and standards.
