#1 VA Activates New EHR in Michigan

What Happened:

The VA activates Oracle Health's EHR at four sites in Michigan.

Why It Matters:

The implementations are the first in a wave of re-starts for the VA's EHR modernization program, which had been paused for three years due to cost overruns, technical difficulties, and patient safety concerns.

#2 IKS Health May Acquire TruBridge

What Happened:

India-based IKS Health may acquire TruBridge for \$600 million.

Why It Matters:

The acquisition of TruBridge, which offers health IT and RCM solutions, would bolster RCM vendor IKS Health's offerings and give it a greater presence in India, where TruBridge also has a base of operations.

#3 Click Therapeutics Raises \$50 Million

What Happened:

Click Therapeutics raises \$50 million in a Series D funding round.

Why It Matters:

The funding will enable the digital therapeutics company to pivot from research to commercialization of its line of app-based treatments.

#4 Luminai Announces Series B Funding

What Happened:

Luminai raises \$38 million in Series B funding.

Why It Matters:

The funding round, which brings the company's total raised to \$60 million, will enable it to expand the capabilities of its automated healthcare operations software.

#5 Remission Medical Raises \$5 Million

What Happened:

Remission Medical announces \$5 million in funding.

Why It Matters:

The virtual rheumatology care software and services company will use the investment to expand into new specialties.
