#1 Sectra Acquires Oxipit

What Happened:

Medical imaging vendor Sectra acquires Oxipit.

#4 UnityPoint Health to Outsource IT, RCM

What Happened:

UnityPoint Health will lay off and then outsource IT and RCM roles.

Why It Matters:

UnityPoint's decision to lay off hundreds of employees in favor of outsourcing their functions to third-party vendors reflects the increasingly drastic cost-cutting measures hospitals are taking to keep their doors open.

#5 The DOJ Accuses Zealhy of Fraud

What Happened:

The DOJ accuses telehealth startup Zealhy of widespread fraud.

Why It Matters:

Zealhy, which has been on the DOJ's radar since 2024, is being accused of issuing prescriptions using doctors' identities without their consent, among other fraudulent practices. The company faces an asset freeze and receivership.
